## 108th WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES

## **Pastoral Suggestions**

- 1. Build awareness of the World Day of Migrants and Refugees through the parish bulletin, a poster, an announcement, a short video on the diocese/parish website, or by preaching a homily focused on Migrants and Refugees;
- 2. Praying for Migrants & Refugees: include prayers for them in the prayers of the faithful;
- 3. Recognize and thank the refugee sponsorship committee in your parish, if one exists;
- 4. Recognize a refugee family that has been sponsored by the parish;
- 5. Begin a parish refugee committee and sponsor a refugee;
- 6. Invite and encourage parishioners to volunteer as members of a parish refugee committee.

For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me a drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, sick and you took care of me, in prison and you visited me" (Mt 25:34-36)."

  - For the many volunteers who carry out loving deeds and who are dedicated to welcoming refugees, may they know the love and blessing of God. We pray to the Lord.
  - That we may accept the gift of migrants and refugees with open hands and heart. We pray to the Lord.
  - For those who escaped from war and poverty that they may find people to welcome them.
